

MINUTES FOR THE OCTOBER 11, 1979, ANNUAL MEETING OF THE GODDARD RUNNING AND JOGGING CLUB

The meeting was called to order by President Bill Wooden. Minutes were read and approved. The Treasurer's report was given by Ed Stengard showing a balance on hand of \$61.50. Our expenditures for the year were \$21.50 for magazines.

President Bill Wooden thanked his officers for their effort and support during the past year; also, thanks went to Frank Stocklin as chairman of the Run Cmte., to Blake Lorenz for compiling the data from the April Intercenter run which Goddard hosted, and to Bob McDonnell for organizing the luncheon for Tuesday.

The slate of officers for the upcoming 1979-1980 year was drawn up by Ray Hartenstein, Harry Trexel and Jane Jonker.

Candidates for President: Bill Wooden and Frank Stocklin - no other nominations from the floor. Frank Stocklin was elected by majority vote and took over the meeting.

Candidates for Vice-Pres.: Jane Jonker and Emil Kirwan. Jane Jonker was elected.

Candidates for Secretary: Zaiga Tums and Gene Humphrey. Zaiga was elected.

Candidates for Treasurer: Ed Stengard and George Griffin. George was elected.

John Sissala explained his contact with the Montgomery County Road Runners and the tentative plans for a December run with them. However, they have decided to run against clubs, etc., only in Montgomery County. John then suggested setting up runs with other government agencies in PG County. Suggestion for the Run Committee.

Bill Wooden reminded members of the Inter-Agency runs held at the Tidal Basin the 3rd Wednesday of every month which we would be eligible to enter. Pete Hui added that arrangements for changing, showering, etc., could be made with Headquarters.

Bill Wooden moved that we re-subscribe to Running Times and Runner's World magazines. We decided to continue the subscriptions after a unanimous vote.

Bill then suggested we subscribe to The Runner magazine.

Discussion followed: Blake Lorenz suggested asking GEWA to finance that subscription and a wheel for measurements.

John Sissala suggested books and magazines be donated for lending use in the Fitness Room.

Bill Wooden suggested asking for money from GEWA to establish a lending library consisting of various books, magazines, etc.

Frank Stocklin will check with GEWA regarding this.

Harry Trexel moved that we ask GEWA for \$100.00 for the Lending Library, if not able to obtain then to set aside \$25.00 from our treasury (per year) for books. Motion passed.

Frank asked Bill to come up with a list of suggested books/magazines to present to GEWA.

It was also suggested that a sign be placed in the Fitness Room asking for Book/magazine donations and one asking for suggestions for books/magazines for the 'Lending Library'.

John Sissala suggested for the club to sponsor a 3-mile run for the 2nd Wednesday of every month. This could be varied by using different courses and would provide an opportunity to know club members and a bit more cohesiveness than the annual meeting provides.

Blake Lorenz suggested a dual run with Headquarters to be held at Goddard and downtown. This could be arranged through Herb Chislom and/or Tony Diamond at H'qters.

Jane Jonker suggested a 2-mile predicted time Turkey Trot for November.

Frank ask Jane to serve as Run Cmte Chairman, which she agreed to.

Frank then suggested a Handicapped Run.

Steve Derdeyn suggested a baton for taking pulse as you run be invested in by the club. Frank asked Pete Hui to get more info on this for consideration.

Frank mentioned possibility of changing route for 10K run for April's Inter-center run. If anyone has any suggestions as to a flat, closed course within easy access of Goddard please let one of the officers know.

John Sissala moved a new date for the annual meeting be set which would be before the fiscal year ends. The 2nd Monday in September was decided on and at this time the club will vote on changing the constitution to read as such.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn.
