Goddard hosts 8th NASA Intercenter Runs

Report from Donna McDuffie Kahle (Code 205)

The 8th NASA Intercenter Runs were held at Goddard during the first part of October. We had a fine showing of 95 runners in the 2-Mile as compared with 78 in last April's run. Out of the 95, 49 ran both last April and this October - 39 with improved times! Bill Wooden (582) led the circuit with a time of 10:52. He was followed by Dick Strafella (581) in 11:12.

Claire Parkinson (913) and Relda Casper (310) turned in times of 13:22 and 13:58 respectively, leading the six women participants. Four men in the 55 years-and-over age group completed, rounding out Goddard's participation in all the age groups.

Our 10-kilometer run was snowed out (!) on October 10th. However, we postponed until the following week to turn in 54 times, with 46 men and eight women running.

Bill Wooden bettered last April's time of 37:18 with 36:04 for the Greenbelt Lake course. Dick Strafella, Ray Hartenstein (714), John Sissala (415) and Tom Warlan (911) also clocked in under 40 minutes. Claire Parkinson led the women's field of eight runners with 46:05 followed by Relda Casper in 46:41.

Since the beginning of the NASA-wide competition in 1976, Goddard has shown continual improvement in both numbers of participants and performance. Start planning now to join us for the April, 1980 competition!

Dialogues with Management bridge communications gap

Over 100 Goddard employees attended "Dialogues with Management" hosted by the Federal Women's Program October 31.
