Mr. Niumatalolo is an American football coach and former player. He has served as the head football coach at the U.S. Naval Academy since 2007. He played college football at the University of Hawaii. As a quarterback he led the then-Rainbows to their first post-season bowl game in 1989. He's the second person of Polynesian descent to be named head coach of a NCAA Division I FBS college football program, and the first Samoan collegiate head coach on any level. Dr. Shin manages the agency's aeronautics research portfolio and guides its strategic direction. This portfolio includes research in the fundamental aeronautics of flight, aviation safety and the nation's airspace system. He also co-chairs the National Science & Technology Council's Aeronautics Science & Technology Subcommittee. Comprised of federal departments and agencies that fund aeronautics-related research, the subcommittee wrote the nation's first Presidential policy for aeronautics research and development (R&D).
