Participation is limited to NASA employees (including retirees), on-site contractors, co-op students at work, and NRC fellows on-site. Dependents may participate in the runs, but will not in any way affect the scoring to determine the winning Center. If you can't make these dates or wish to improve on your time, you may run any TAC/RRCA certified course during the March 14-April 19 time period and submit the official results to Chuck Naegeli, Code 732. The scoring for the Centers is based on a formula that tallies place points, quartile points, total number of finishers, and a bonus based on the percentage of the Center participating. This last area is where Goddard is the weakest--we finished third overall last fall even though first in place points. So come out and enjoy (walkers are welcome), get a ribbon, and help Goddard win a gold medal!
