The artist's statement has more to do with the particular art that you are sending. Say something about how you created it, what meaning it may have, and how it relates to the subject of the call.

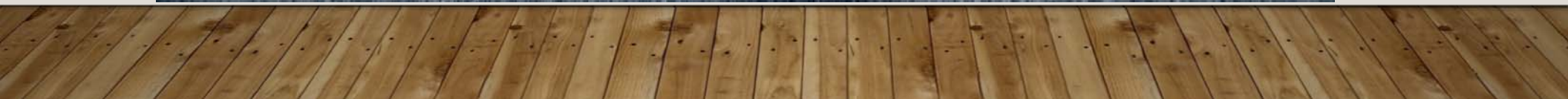
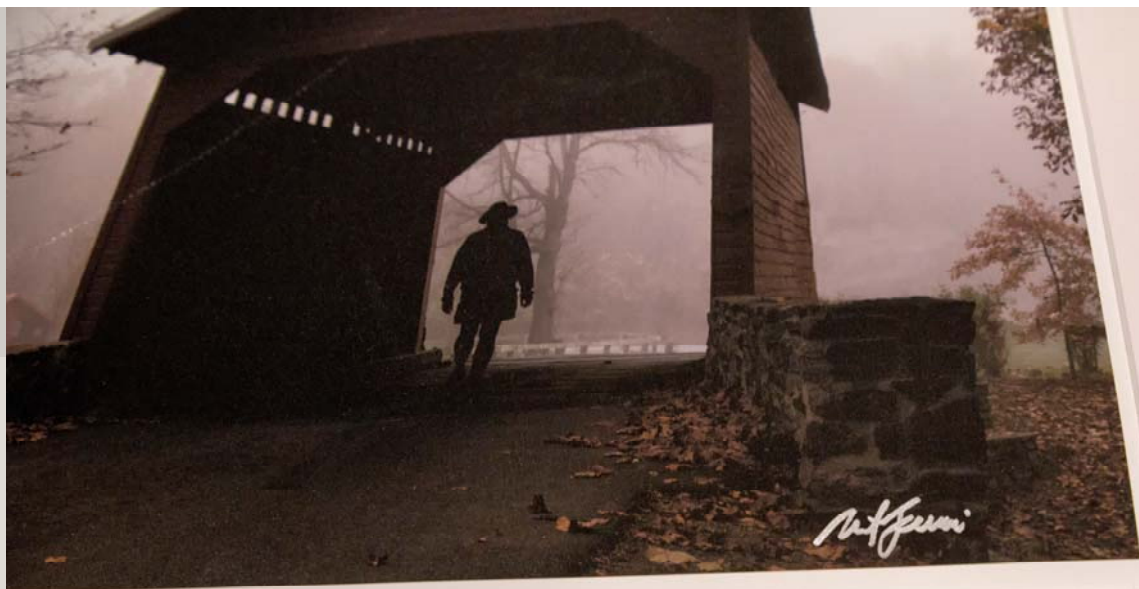
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Cutting your own mats and framing yourself can save you a small fortune.

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If shipping your work is required, packing is very important. Use a sturdy box, with plenty of packing materials. Don't use peanuts!



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You will save money by self-packing and paying on-line with Fed Ex or UPS.



Keep a record of exhibits that you have been accepted into, and keep it up to date.
